This Certificate of TVET Program Registration is hereby granted pursuant to Republic Act No. 7796 creating the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and in accordance with TESDA Board Resolution 98-03 on the Establishment of the Unified TVET Program Registration and Accreditation System (UTPRAS) dated January 23, 1998 and TESDA Circulars No. 17 and No. 12 Series of 2007 Omnibus Amendatory Guidelines on UTPRAS as amended by TESDA Circular No. 45 Series of 2007.

Furthermore, the Institution must comply with the following:

1. Within a period of one year upon the effectivity of an updated Training Regulations (TR) and upon due notification from TESDA, a WTR program shall be submitted for re-evaluation and re-registration in accordance with the updated Training Regulations. A program which is not re-registered within the prescribed period shall be subject to closure proceedings.
2. Students graduating from a WTR program shall undergo mandatory assessment as a requirement for graduation. WTR programs shall be reviewed after the first three (3) batches of the programs based on the employment and certification rates of the graduates which shall not be lower than the regional/sectoral average. WTR programs with employment and certification rates lower than the regional/sectoral average for three (3) consecutive batches shall be subject to closure proceedings.
3. All registered programs shall be subject to regular compliance audit by TESDA or a recognized auditing body to ensure continuing compliance with the minimum standards.
4. The TESDA Regional/Provincial/District Director shall be informed of any changes in trainer/s and shall subsequently issue a certification as to the new trainers with corresponding NTTC numbers.


Incentives shall be extended to institutions which are consistently performing within the above prescribed standards.

This Certificate of TVET Program Registration shall be subject to revocation should the institution fail to faithfully comply with the rules and regulations governing the offering of TVET programs prescribed by the Authority.

This Certificate shall not extend to any other program or any other branch of the Institution.
